Create an Emergency Plan

- □ Plan evacuation routes and meeting points
- Compile emergency contact list
- Designate a communication method (including out-of-town contact)
- Plan for pets, elderly, disabled family members
- Know your flood zone: <u>FEMA Flood Map</u>

Build an Emergency Kit

- **3**-day supply of non-perishable food & water per person
- Cold storage backup (PCM packs, cooler, or generator)
- Medications & First Aid kit
- □ Flashlights, batteries, LED lanterns
- Multi-tool kit, duct tape, rope, manual can opener
- Extra clothes, blankets, and sturdy shoes
- Copies of personal documents & emergency cash
- □ Toiletries, soap, sanitary products
- □ Whistle, matches, notepad, and pen

Stay Informed

- □ Sign up for emergency alerts
- Follow FEMA & <u>National Hurricane Center</u>

Use a battery-powered NOAA Weather Radio

Secure Your Home

- □ Anchor heavy furniture & appliances
- □ Install storm shutters or board up windows
- Have fire extinguishers and charged smoke detectors
- □ Learn how to shut off gas, water, and electricity
- □ Take photos & update home insurance
- Store patio furniture in your pool (if applicable)
